
Interland is an online adventure game that makes learning about digital safety and citizenship interactive and fun. It teaches the key lessons of internet safety through four fun, challenging games.

The **erase|Report It** tool lets you send a secure, anonymous and confidential message to your school or school district's safe school coordinator, who will follow up on it right away. You do not have to provide your name unless you want to.



Students respond to cyberbullying scenarios and are prompted to make choices to evolve into an upstander.




Students reflect on what it's like to multitask on a cellphone and consider the benefits of focusing on one task at a time.


